Jacob Hooisma (1945-1994) was one of the founders of INA, the organizer of the first INA meeting in 1987 and the first INA secretary. He is best known for his research using neurobehavioral methods for evaluating the effects of neurotoxic exposures in working populations. Unfortunately, he passed away at the age of 49 after falling ill with an untreatable form of cancer. In honor of his memory the “Jacob Hooisma Memorial Lecture” is held by a distinguished toxicologist every INA meeting.
